The DANIEL FAST

Daniel 1:12

"Please test your servants... Give us nothing but vegetables to eat and water to drink."



The DANIEL FAST

In Daniel Chapter 1 we learn about the Daniel fast. When Daniel and his three friends (Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah) were taken captive to Babylon, they were chosen to be trained to serve in King Nebuchadnezzar's palace. Part of their training included eating rich food and wine from the king's table. However, Daniel didn't want to defile himself with this food, so he asked permission to eat only vegetables and drink water instead.

Daniel requested a test: if he and his friends looked healthier than the others afterward, they could continue their diet. The official agreed. After 10 days, they appeared stronger and healthier than the young men who ate the king's food, so they were allowed to continue their plant-based diet. As a result of their obedience, God gave them knowledge, wisdom, and understanding.

On June 23rd, we begin 7 days of the Daniel Fast. As we draw nearer to the Lord, He will bless us with knowledge, wisdom, and understanding.

FOOD GUIDE

✓ Foods you can eat (Plant Based Only)

- **Fruits** (fresh, frozen, or dried with no added sugar)

Examples: apples, bananas, berries, oranges, grapes

- **Vegetables** (fresh, frozen, or cooked with no additives)

Examples: carrots, spinach, broccoli, potatoes, kale

- **Whole Grains**

Examples: brown rice, oats, quinoa, whole wheat pasta, barley

- **Legumes**

Examples: lentils, black beans, chickpeas, peas

- **Nuts & Seeds** (raw, unsalted)

Examples: almonds, sunflower seeds, walnuts, chia seeds

- **Natural Oils** (for cooking in moderation)

Examples: olive oil, coconut oil, avocado oil

- **Water** (main beverage)

You may also have 100% fruit juice in small amounts (no sugar added)

✗ Foods to Avoid

- Meat, poultry, or fish
- Dairy products (milk, cheese, butter, yogurt)
- Processed foods
- Refined grains (white rice, white bread, etc.)
- Sugar or sweeteners (including honey, syrup, candy)
- Caffeine or soda
- Fried foods or junk food
- Baked goods with leavening (like yeast or baking powder)
