



CREED OF FAITH

THE TRINITY

1 God, 3 persons. Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Mt. 28:19). The Father set up the plan for salvation for those far from Him to be brought into His family (Eph. 1:5-6, Galatians 4:6). Jesus Christ, the Son of God, enacted the plan of salvation by dying on the cross, covering all who repent and believe in Him (1 Pet. 1:8), and who is now in Heaven interceding for us (Rom. 8:34). The Spirit is our Seal (Eph. 1:13), Helper (Jn. 14:26), and guarantee of salvation who never leaves us and transforms us to look like Christ in our mind and conduct (Eph. 1:14; Is. 59:21; 2 Cor., 3:18). We believe that Jehovah was rejected in the Garden of Eden, Christ was rejected by man and crucified. Therefore, to avoid making the same mistake in these times, we want to honor the Holy Spirit by intentionally recognizing Him.

THE BIBLE

We believe in the full inspiration of the Holy Scriptures. Everything God wanted written in the Bible has been faithfully preserved without error or failure (Jn. 10:35). These 66 books are perfectly able to guide the Christian in conduct and perfectly discloses what God wants for His people and who He is (2 Tim. 3:16).

BAPTISM

To be baptized is to be submerged in water after one confesses, repents of their sin, and gives their life to the Lordship of Jesus Christ (Acts 2:38). Water baptism represents how we die to our old selves and are raised to new life in Jesus (Col. 2:12-13). We do not believe in infant baptism, as the Scriptures indicate that this act requires repentance, which can only come from an adult capable of recognizing their sins (Acts 2:38). Jesus set the example by being baptized as an adult, and He was dedicated as a child (Matthew 3:13-17, Luke 2:21-40).

CHRIST'S RETURN

Jesus returns for His children, the church (1 Thes. 4:16-17; Rev. 19:7). Those who believed in His Name and followed Him faithfully in this life will be united with Him forever relationally in the New Heaven and New Earth, established when He returns (Is. 65:15-20; Rev. 21:1-8). No more sadness, no more tears, and life forevermore await the Christian. To those who refused to submit to Jesus are then sentenced to eternity without Him in eternal condemnation in hell (Mt. 10:33, 24:48-51). Eternal life is obtained solely through Salvation offered by Christ Jesus. Each of us must acknowledge our sinful state and our dependency on God, achieved through repentance. Romans 10:9 emphasizes the importance of confessing Jesus as our Savior and believing in our hearts that He died and rose again on the third day.

MARRIAGE

At creation, God ordained marriage to be sacred forever: The union between one man and one woman for life (Gen. 2:24). Life cannot happen without the marital union (fruitfulness and multiplication, seen in Gen. 1:28). Therefore, marriage is reserved for one man (biologically born male) and one woman (biologically born female) to be united in one flesh for one lifetime (Mk. 10:6-12)

LIFE

Life is sacred and should be protected at all costs (Acts 17:25). Therefore, abortion in an act of convenience cannot be condoned and actively goes against God's plan of fruitfulness and multiplication (Gen. 1:28). Those who have undergone abortion are to be loved and shown the restoration that God alone provides (Luke 17:3)
